DIVERSITY



In order to enhance multi-cultural and multi-lingual interaction in the school, 20% of our students are from Hong Kong's non-Chinese community while 80% of students are locals.

This allows dialogue between local Chinese and non-Chinese speaking (NCS) students, and fosters the understanding of each other's cultures through cultural exchanges and activities that the College organises throughout the school year. Mingling between Chinese and NCS students also helps NCS students adapt more quickly to the local culture.



Events such as Cultural Weeks and Talent Quests allow NCS students to showcase their culture and creativity by performing their traditional artistic performances, and raise the Chinese students' awareness of different cultures, leading to a more welcoming society for all.

The College ensures that no student is left behind. Most activities the college organises are conducted in English. In activities where an English option is not found, translations will be provided.

PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION

The Parent-Teacher Association also organises activities conducted in English, as the College acknowledges the important role that parents play in the development of all students.

ALL-ROUND DEVELOPMENT



Students are supported to develop their own potential with various learning experiences outside classroom.



STUDY TOURS

The college has implemented the "Experiential Learning in Expeditions (ELITE) Programme". Each Junior Form student is required to join at least ONE of the overseas study tours. Activities such as field trips and visits to

places of interest complement classroom learning and provide a meaningful context for students to consolidate their subject knowledge.

STUDENT EVENTS

We believe the College should be a place where individual talents are nurtured, encouraged and developed through a well-balanced education. Various leadership training programmes, sharing and visits are organised to prepare them to become future leaders.



CAREER GUIDANCE

To prepare students for their further studies and career development, Life Planning Education Programmes are implemented in junior forms to enhance students' self-understanding, goal-setting and self-reflection skills.

IN CATERING FOR INDIVIDUAL DIFFERENCES

The College has implemented language and curriculum sets in Junior Forms for core subjects. There are variations in the curriculum content and teaching strategies of different curriculum sets to accommodate students' diverse learning needs.



CHINESE AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (CSL)

The College provides abundant support for non-Chinese speaking students to facilitate their learning of Chinese. Students' varied learning needs are catered for with a school-based Chinese Language curriculum and small class teaching, allowing them to learn more effectively. In addition, after school programmes like Chinese Remedial Class and Chinese Tutorial Room are organised to support students' learning of Chinese.

To motivate students to learn Chinese and experience Chinese culture, a wide range of activities are designed, such as drama activities, group presentations, culture experiential learning programmes, and excursions like museum visits and tea appreciation. Our students have achieved outstanding results in GCSE (Chinese).



FRENCH



French is offered as a second language in junior forms and an elective in senior forms. The French curriculum helps non-Chinese speaking students discover French culture and develop their ability to become independent learners in the French language.

Beginning in Form 1, students will be taking French classes. From Form 4 onwards, students will be taught the necessary skills to take the HKDSE in Form 6. Our French HKDSE results are consistently far better than the Hong Kong norms.



Every year, our students participate and do well in various French competitions, namely French Speech Festival, French Dictation and HK-France Prize for Social Innovation.

Numerous activities are also organised to arouse students' interest in learning French and experience French culture, such as Drama Workshops, Poetry Workshops, Excursions, and Exhibitions.

CHINESE HISTORY FOR NCS STUDENTS



China is one of the world's four ancient civilizations. The written history of China can be said to date back to the Shang Dynasty (1600–1046 BC) over 3,000 years ago. If our students know about the history and development of

China, they can be better prepared to see how China is evolving and foresee how China interacts with people from other countries. The more knowledge our students possess about China and Hong Kong, the better equipped they will be for further development.

Not only will students learn some fundamental historical terms and concepts, they will also learn a few major leaders and characters from each dynasty during Chinese History lessons, so that they can develop a better understanding of Chinese cultures, customs and religions.



Our school-based Chinese History curriculum provides students with meaningful learning experiences. In order to suit the individual needs of NCS students, the College has developed school-based Chinese History learning materials for all our junior form NCS students.

VPET PROMOTION COMPETITION

Our students were tasked with promoting the VPET programme for the “Aviation Industry”. The team’s creativity was on full display when they presented to the judges the logo, the mascot, the slogan, and a multi-media audio tape closely knitted to the marketing strategies that they were proposing. The team was awarded the overall Champion.

STUDENT OF THE YEAR

Karndeeep Singh, the former President of the Student Council Orion, was among 5 students from local and international schools in Hong Kong who received The Student of the Year – Best Devotion to School Award.

He was awarded the prize for his commitment and dedication to the school as a responsible student leader, who organized school- and online-based activities in spite of the pandemic and for being a good team player and an exemplary role model.



HKDSE RESULTS

Since 2012, our DSE results have continued remarkably above and beyond the Hong Kong norms, including both passing and credit rates achieved in individual subjects. The UER (University Entrance Requirement) is markedly higher than the Hong Kong average for over 20% in the past few years.

OUR STUDENTS' LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES



As part of our ongoing efforts to recognise outstanding S1 students, scholarships will be offered to S1 entrants for the coming year. Each scholarship holder will be granted a six-year full school fee subsidy.

To ensure that students are not deprived of the chance to study at our College solely because of financial difficulties, the College offers a financial assistance scheme to needy families (including those receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance or assistance from the Student Financial Assistance Agency). Eligible applicants will be granted either full or half-level school fee reduction.
